

RAPID System Upgrade

RAPID Incident Reporting System is receiving an upgrade, which will come into effect on 1st December 2021. The current version of RAPID will not be available after 1st December 2021, but will be available to the CSHWSA Team for historical data. How you access and use the RAPID Data Base System will not change, only some fields will change. The upgrade will assist with reporting and trend identification.

Changes

- Addition of categories
- Expansion of types of incidents under categories
- Addition of personnel type
- Updated risk matrix
- Addition of mechanism of injury (injured by another person)
- Simplification of root causes
- Changes to locations and sub locations (simplified)

| Risk Level | Risk Score | Timeframe for Implementation of Control Measures |
|------------|------------|--|
| High | 20 to 25 | Act Immediately or within 24 hours to lower the risk to an acceptable level or as low as reasonably practicable. |
| Medium | 11 to 19 | Act within 21 days to reduce the risk to an acceptable level or as low as reasonably practicable. |
| Low | 1 to 10 | Act within 60 days to reduce the risk to an acceptable level or as low as reasonably practicable. |

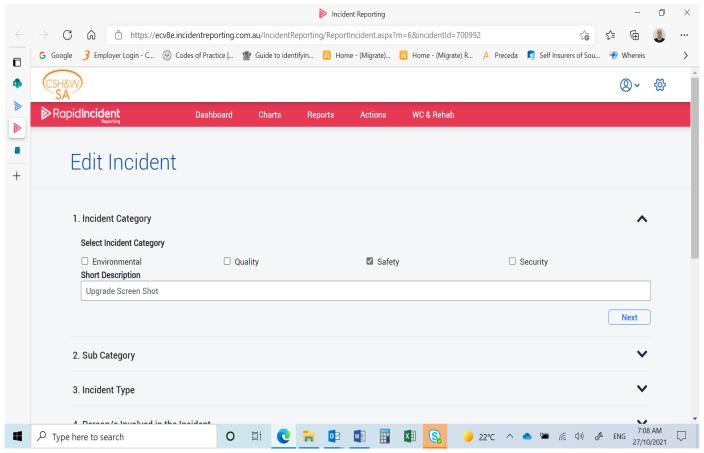

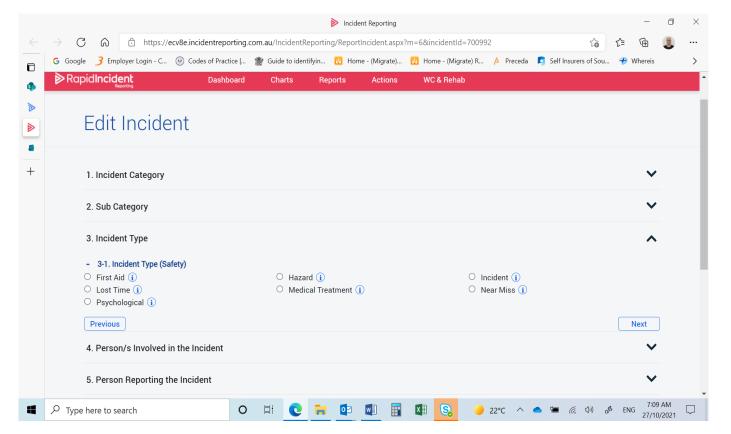

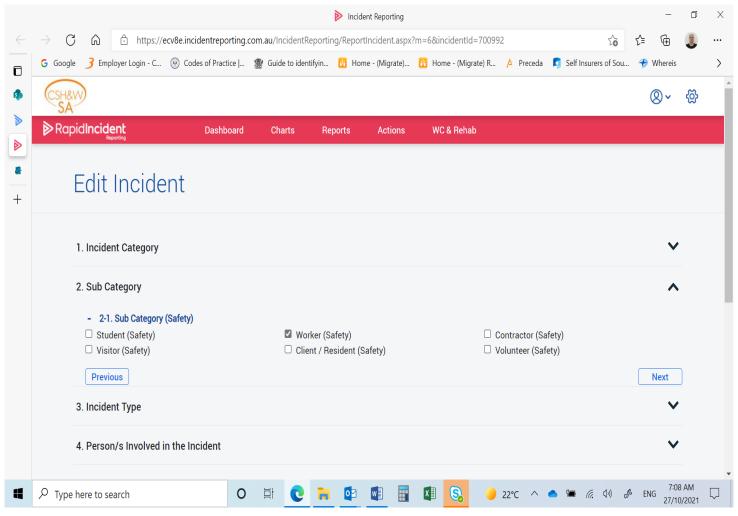


Screen shot of incident type changes
